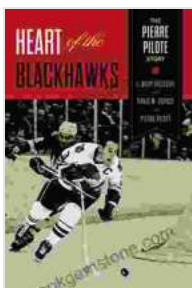


Heart of the Blackhawks: The Pierre Pilote Story

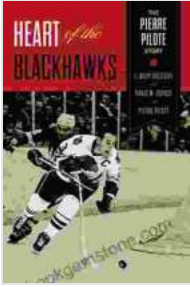

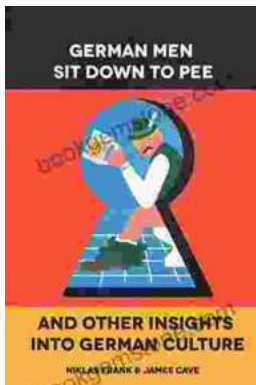
