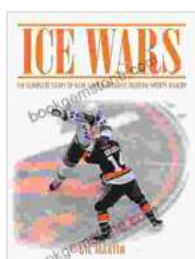

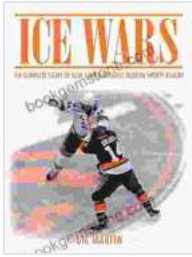

The Future of the Rivalry

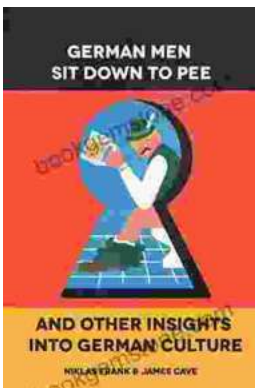
