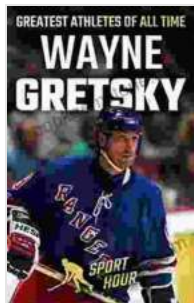

Early Life and Career

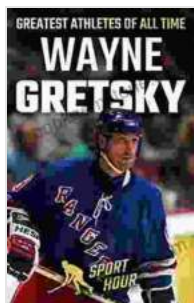

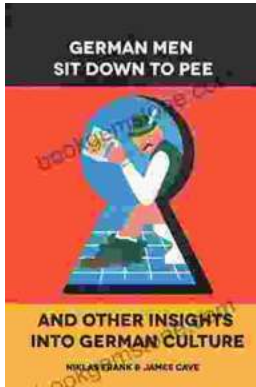

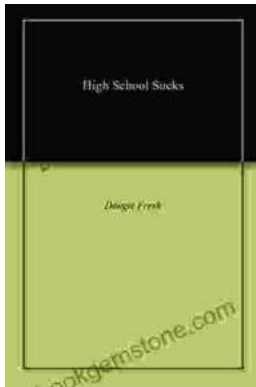
